Notice to the public is hereby given that the Southwest Air Pollution Control Authority has made a preliminary Determination to issue a Regulatory Order of Approval, number SWAPCA (87)-(901), to American Cabinet Concepts, Inc. for wood cabinet manufacturing. Emissions of up to 90 pounds per day of volatile organic compounds and five pounds per day of particulates.
