Notice to the public is hereby given that the Southwest Clean Air Agency (SWCAA) is providing a thirty (30) day public comment period for the preliminary determination to issue Air Discharge Permit 06-2691R2 to Hampton Lumber Mills - Randle Facility. The preliminary determination approves the installation of a replacement sawdust cyclone. No new processes are proposed. No emission increase is proposed.
