

PUBLIC NOTICE

Notice to the public is hereby given that the Southwest Clean Air Agency (SWCAA) is providing a 30 day public comment period for the preliminary determination to issue Air Discharge Permit 10-2924R3 to Oregon Iron Works, LLC. This preliminary determination approves an increase in the existing VOC emission limit for spray coating operations at a heavy steel fabrication facility located at 3515 SE Columbia Way, Building 48 in Vancouver, Washington. The approved increase raises the VOC emission limit from 20.0 tpy to 25.0 tpy. This action does not approve new equipment or any change in general operation. All other existing emission limits remain in effect.

Copies of the preliminary Air Discharge Permit and associated Technical Support Document are available for review at 11815 NE 99th Street, Suite 1294, Vancouver, Washington, Monday through Friday from 7:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Electronic copies are available for review in the permit section of SWCAA's internet website (www.swcleanair.org/permitprelims.asp). This material will be made available in other media, if necessary. All written or oral comments must be received by SWCAA within thirty (30) days after the date of publication. Final action by SWCAA to approve, modify, or deny the proposal will be taken within ten (10) days after the close of the comment period. If there is significant public interest, a public meeting may be held at the discretion of the agency's Executive Director.
