DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE (DNS) – SWCAA 18-026

Description of proposal:

ADP Application L-694: The proposed project will install a new spray coating booth at an existing plywood manufacturing plant. No changes will be made to existing operations. The spray coating booth will be located inside an existing building. The project does not involve new building construction, excavation or paving. Existing impacts to all media other than air will remain unchanged. Air impacts will be minimized through the use of process enclosure, low VOC coatings and particulate filtration.
